1.1 INTRODUCTION

Drawing is a creative art which communicates the ideas, feelings and thoughts of the artist. It is a form of visual communication which creates a profound long term impact on the viewer's mind. It is the straight acknowledgment of visual objects, feelings, ideas, and dreams, including symbols and even abstract forms. Drawings were the basic forms of expressions of one's thoughts since the Stone Age. Its set of experiences dated back to even before the times languages were framed.

No wonder incalculable drawing styles and techniques have developed after some time. There are various types of drawing dependent on types of drawing styles, kinds of drawing methods and media. Drawing types of art are diverse all around the world. Various kinds of drawing technique are accessible to practice and gain expertise.

1.2 TYPES OF DRAWING

There are different types of drawings like

- Fine Art Drawing
- Diagrammatic Drawing
- Geometric Drawing
- Architectural Drawing
- Analytic Drawing
- 3D Drawing / Anamorphic Drawing

But, when we learn fashion sketches, we learn these types of fashion drawing.

Flat sketch drawing

The most important fashion sketches that play major role in producing a garment like creases, zippers, manages, style lines, stitch lines and specialized equipment of garment.

Flat fashion sketch permit the seam stress and creation unit to understand the design and acts as the main communication tool to make clothing alive.

Tech sketch drawing

This is a flat sketch with details of the garment written in text.

Quick sketch drawing

A "sketch" is usually a speedy and loosely drawn work; Fashion sketching propels a designer's ideas from page to creation. The first step in this process is called a "croquis"—a quick sketch of a human body that serves as the template for a piece of clothing or outfit.

Specification drawing

This is a more exact show of the garment, with all details included on it like the fabric utilized, trims utilized, the amount it will cost to deliver etc.; this is utilized for the manufacturing cycle.

Working drawing

This is the drawing introduced to the pattern maker with all the information required by him to make the pattern pieces. Fabric samples, the fasteners utilized ought to be remembered for the complete information passed on with the working drawing.

Presentation drawing

This is the final drawing that a fashion designer makes to present to a customer or producer.

Fashion croquis

Croquis means sketch in French; in fashion, this refers to a figurative fashion template. The drawing of a figure can be utilized as a format over which you can follow and draw a design or garment.

Adobe illustrator drawing

The inclusion of Adobe Illustrator in fashion and design courses as a component of CAD is done for good reasons. The software has been enabling artist to make proficient standard vector graphics. Illustrator can positively make your creativity shine.

1.3 TOOL KIT REQUIRED FOR DRAWING

Fashion sketchbook

Fashion sketchbooks are combined with extensive fashion information and figure formats. The templates are barely visible, which makes it simple to sketch your design over them. Fashion sketch books come in two sizes: A4 and A5.

The fashion sketchbook consists of the relative multitude of drawings you have made – it is a collection of all your ideas. Sometimes the initial thought is sketched.

Drawing pencils

Good pencils like HB, B and 2B are used for drawing shapes and 4B, 6B & 8B pencils are used for shading and highlighting.

Sharpeners and erasers

It's very important to draw with fine lines. Pencils should be sharpened well and erasers should be used to erase when required.

Colors

Pastel colors and color pencils are used for filling color. Water color pencils can be used to have watercolor effects and if you use a paint brush along with it to blend the colors no one would be able to judge that it is made with a pencil.

After sketching with pencils, you can apply watercolors to your designs. To get paint from a pan, use a brush to pick up a color. Then, put it on your palette and mix it with a variety of colors to get the ones you want.



1.4 IMPORTANT ASPECTS OF FASHION DRAWING

The primary feature of your fashion sketch ought to be garments and nothing else. You are introducing the garment and when drawing you ought not to neglect to focus on this. All the other things ought to be secondary and should be complementing your garments.

In you can introduce the texture of the fabric and the wrap of the folds of the fabric you will have an extraordinary drawing. For that, you should dominate some drawing techniques which are not difficult to master but can create a stunning effect on your final sketch.

The piece of clothing isn't drawn from one side. You will be approached to introduce the piece of clothing from all sides. If you can get a 3-dimensional view with your drawings you will have a winner of a fashion sketch.

1.5 ELEMENTS OF DESIGNS

The elements are fundamentals for any design. The elements go about as tools and principles go about as guidelines on how to utilize the elements. Details that form an essential piece of the articles of clothing are structural designs. These might be straightforward or elaborate. The applied design utilized in limited areas produce a coordinated impression. The size of the applied design identifies with the size of the space that it occupies.

1.5.1 Line: Line is the strongest and most important domain.

Types of lines

- Diagonal

- Zigzag

In garments lines can be categorized in threeways

1) Type

- ➤ Straight line: All garments have some straight lines in them which help to emphasize body angularity and neutralize the roundness of the body. Seams, darts, yokes, hems or article of clothing edges, trims, pleats, hems, tucks, braids, zippers, rows of buttons and panels are for the most part straight lines. Straight lines oppose normal curves and signify permanence, neatness and strength. They render a feeling of elegance, bold and incredible, steady and impacts in an article of clothing. Utilize just limited number of straight lines in a dress as more straight lines can give a stiffer and slimmer look.
- ➤ Curve line: Curved lines are less moderate, formal and powerful than straight lines. Circles and curves make spaces look bigger than they truly are. They augment the size and shape of the figure adding interest to a design. They give soft, delicate, youthful and flowing impact.
- ➤ Zigzag line: These lines have sharp focuses like zigzags, which change the direction suddenly because of their points. This type of line gives a feeling of jerky, busy, excited impact. They also emphasize angularity. At the point when they are utilized beyond what is required these lines can make a feeling of confusion in dress. As they are truly recognizable their utilization ought to be limited. Decorative fabric pattern and trim like rickrack can assist with making this effect. They are additionally used to combine various pattern and textures.

2) Direction

- ➤ Vertical: Dresses having vertical lines whenever worn by a thin person makes the person look much taller and thinner. Vertical lines are found in a shirt front, princess lines, darts, pleats, tucks and in fabric pattern. These lines are best utilized on short and heavy figures.
- ➤ Horizontal: These lines will direct the viewer across the article of clothing, emphasizing figure's width by then. They give the impression of more width and less height. The figure looks shorter and wider. Horizontal lines are found at waistlines, hemline, wide neck area, sleeves, collars, boards, midsections and in belts.
- ➤ **Diagonal:** Diagonal lines in an article of clothing will in general slenderize the entire body, more than vertical lines. They are solid and draw attention to the area where they are utilized. Hence if a feeling of movement or speed is desired, or a feeling of activity, diagonal lines can be utilized.

3) Application

- ➤ Structural: Structural lines are generally visible if the fabric of the garment is plain. They can be presented through constructional lines like seams, darts, fitting tucks and shirring. Wrinkles and fold created by pleats, gathers etc. also give structural line impact in an article of clothing.
- ➤ **Decorative:** Decorative lines are made by adding details to the surface of clothing. They are added just to embellish the piece of clothing and make it really interesting. They add style and personality. They can be formed by adding lines of , buttons, topstitching, piping, bias binding, ribbon edging, faggoting, ruffles etc. fabric pattern like stripes, plaids, herringbones, checks etc. also add lines decoratively.

1.5.2 Dot:

Dot is known as basic element of point. It is the smallest unit suggesting its essence and area. The size of the dots additionally passes on a message. The bigger the dot is, the more expanded the surface shows up, and the vice versa. Subsequently, a thin figure should wear a dress of bigger dot to cover the figure issue. A chain of specks become a line.

Types of dots

- Uneven dots
- Even dots
- Small dots
- Big dots
- Scattered dots

1.5.3 Shape:

Shapes have both physical and psychological effects on the lines surrounding them. Space within the shapes and separating the shapes also has an impact. The word "shape" usually suggests geometric shapes and there are many shapes such as flat ones with equivalent sides - square, circle, pentagon, hexagon, and octagon; with unequal shapes like oval, triangle, diamond, square, equivalent side's three-dimensional shapes like sphere and cube. But original forms are rarely seen in dresses: however the garment shapes suggest these forms.

1.5.4 Form:

Form like sphere, cone, box, dome and etc. can be introduced structurally into garments through incorporation of puff sleeves, skirts, lehangha, and formal gent's suit. Some general guideline to be continued in introducing the above ought to be in harmony between different proportion and with the entire garment.

1.5.5 Texture:

Texture is the element of design that describes surface appearance and feel understood by sight just as by touch. It also means the presence of the fabric. It is the quality of roughness or smoothness, dullness or glossiness, stiffness or softness quality. Some words to describe the texture of fabrics are: rough, smooth, dull, shiny, firm, crisp, fluffy, bulky, dull etc. Texture is characterized as tactile quality of a fabric. Hand alludes to the tactile parts of the fabric. Texture has the definite physical dimensions of weight, size, mass and shape. There are two kinds of surfaces textures — structural texture, which is made when fabrics or garments are manufactured, and added visual surfaces, which come when a design is printed onto the texture surface. There are different segments like fibers, yarns, fabrics and finishes that determine texture.

1.5.6Color:

Every season colors emerge in the fashion scene which is chosen by the main producers, exporters and textile specialists of the fashion world. Color is the significant deciding factor. Color is a property of light, a sensation, which happens when light enters eyes. Color enables one to express them, to influence the feeling, and furthermore reveal the personality of the wearer. Color has the ability to excite and shock, irritate or soothe, attract or repel.


1.5.7 Space:


1.6 DRAWING OF DIFFERENT BODY PARTS




Drawing of lips










2.1 INTRODUCTION

Color is the most intriguing design component as it is the first thing that meets the eye of the customer. Color is a property of light, a sensation, which happens when light enters the eyes. Color empowers one to put themselves out there, to influence the feelings, and furthermore reveal the personality of the wearer. Color has the ability to excite and shock, disturb or soothe, attract or repulse.

Objects seem hued on the grounds that their surfaces absorb certain parts of the visible range of light and reflect different parts back to our eyes. For example if an item seems blue, it is because that the object absorbed any remaining colored shaded light and reflected just blue color light. Visible spectrum of light or white light contains colors from blue toward one side of the range to red at the opposite end. The closures of this spectra band is twisted and joined to form a color wheel.

2.2 IMPORTANCE OF COLOR IN FASHION

We can say that color is the primary thing people observe in our garments and the effect is instantaneous, and it also leaves a lasting impression. This means, if a person loves wearing a specific color repeatedly, then it's easy to develop an understanding of his / her personality.

Color attracts attention, creates an emotional connection, and leads the purchaser to the item. Color is one of the most important design elements, if not the most significant. There are a few things to keep in mind when developing a color strategy: psychology, culture, trends and more.

The significance of color design comes from the meaning of color to the human brain. Colors make idea, sparkle interest, and produce certain feelings. A few colors hold a universal significance for example, it is regularly perceived that red is a color for warning and green is means go.

2.3 COLOR PROPERTIES / TERMINOLOGY

Hue

It is the family name of a color, which recognizes one tone from the other. It is precise depiction of a color. Hue is a more specialized meaning of our color perception which can be utilized to convey color thoughts. Hues can allude to the arrangement of "pure" colors inside a color space. Hue is the other word for color. The hue names are red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet,\magenta, cyan etc.

Tint

Tint is a color term normally utilized by painters. A tint is a blending result of a unique tone to which has been added white. If you tinted a color, you have been adding white to the original tone. A tint is lighter than the original color. At the point when utilized as a dimension of a color space, tint can be the measure of white added to a unique tone. In such a color space a pure color would be non-tinted.

Shade

Shade is a color term generally utilized by painters. A shade is a blending result of a unique color to which has been added black. If you shaded a color, you have been adding black to the original tone. A shade is darker than the original tone. At the point when utilized as a dimension of a color space, shade can be the amount of black added to an original color. In such a color space a pure color would be non-shaded.

Intensity/ chroma

Intensity is brightness and dullness of a color. The tones on the color wheel are of full intensity. At the point when gray or its complement tone is added it turns out to be less intense. A dull color is unsaturated or low in intensity. A color without any brightness is achromatic (dark, white and / or gray. As per intensity, colors are called as extremely brilliant, bright medium, bright, bright medium, medium dull, dull or very dull. On the other hand black and white are neutrals.

2.4 COLOR WHEEL

A color circle, based on red, yellow and blue, is customary in the field of art.

Primary colors: Red, yellow and blue

In color wheel theory, primary colors are the 3 colors that can't be blended or framed by any mix of different colors. Any remaining colors are gotten from these 3 hues. They are alluded to as primary since they can't be made by blending other color and all other colors can be made by them. The three primary hues are put at equivalent distance from one another on the color wheel.





Figure 1 Primary colors

Secondary colors: Green, orange and purple

They are made by blending equivalent amounts of two primary colors together. They are found somewhere between the primary colors on the color wheel. Orange is made by blending red and yellow. Green is produced using equivalent amounts of blue and yellow. Violet is a combination of red and blue.



Tertiary colors: Yellow - Orange, Red - Orange, Red - Violet, Blue - Green, Blue - Violet, Yellow - Green

Intermediate hues (at times called tertiary hues) result when equivalent amounts of abutting primary and secondary colors are joined. When naming them, it is customary to state the name of the primary hue first for example red - orange is the tertiary among red and orange. Intermediate colors are blue - violet, blue - green, yellow - green, yellow - orange, red - orange, and red -violet.




Figure 3 tertiary colors

2.5 COLOR SCHEME

Color when joined ought to be utilized at the right proportion or, else they conflict and give an awkward appearance as opposed to being excellent. Color scheme is the practice in which those colors are utilized together. A comprehension of well known color scheme assists us with

accomplishing various results by utilizing various combinations of colors. The six fundamental colors schemes are as follows:

Color scheme comprises of at least one of the twelve colors present on the color wheel. By pairing various colors with one another, you can make endless color ranges to use in any composition. Different color combinations evoke various moods or tones by utilizing color theory and color psychology.

(A) Monochromatic color scheme:

A monochromatic color scheme is a one-color scheme that utilizes various tints, and shades. Neutrals like dark and white can be added to a monochromatic scheme for contrast and interest.

By adding hints of white, gray, or black, that single color ventures into a whole range with varying amounts of value. Those tints, tones, and shades give features and shadows to spruce up an otherwise flat color palette.

This color scheme is very flexible and easy on the eye. Utilizing numerous hues in a design can regularly prompt a conflict in colors and obstruct the design's appearance; differentiating color variations on one hue assists to simplify a design without making it excessively level. In the illustration below, the incorporation of dark orange and brown colored give visual interest while as yet keeping the general color scheme minimal.

A monochromatic range doesn't mean the color choice must be exhausting or expected; the color decision simply needs to work inside the setting of the brand or design. When utilizing this color scheme, make certain to know the base color's psychology and how it impacts for the item or design's mood and tone. Utilizing a color palette with hues of comparative worth will make your design flat and one-dimensional.




Figure 4 Monochromatic color schemes

(B) Analogous:

The word "analogous" means closely related, so the mix of these hues has a harmonious appeal like that of monochromatic color schemes. They all have one hue in common so things cannot get too wild. An analogous color scheme with a base hue is extended with two neighboring hues. Analogous colors comprise of a gathering of three colors that border each other inside the color wheel.

These palettes are known to be satisfying to the eyes, so in case you're uncertain of which color scheme to use in your next project, an analogous color palette won't ever disappoint. When picking analogous groups for your project, keep your palette grounded by utilizing only cool or warm colors together.




Figure 5 Analogous

(C) Complementary:

This scheme utilizes colors that are opposite on the color wheel. Complementary colors are opposite to one another on the wheel. They have extraordinary difference. In fact the color looks significantly brighter when they are utilized next to each other. Examples are blue and orange, violet and yellow, and red and green. Worn together in full strength, these colors can give a genuine jolt. Be that as it may, when utilized in colors and shades, they can be modern and satisfying. A delicate color of one is generally appealing with a profound shade of the other.

Colors opposite each other on the color wheel ordinarily give high difference when combined together. At full saturation, complementary hues can be excessively extraordinary for the viewer. To tone down the intensity, incorporate tints, tones, and shades to expand the palette, similarly as with the monochromatic color scheme.




Figure 6 Complementary

(D) Split-complementary color scheme:

A split-complementary color scheme utilizes three tones. It combines one tone with the two colors on the sides of its complement. First pick a color and discover its commendation in the color wheel and then take tones on one or the other side of the compliment. For example, blue may be utilized with yellow-orange and red-orange. This is also a bright color scheme, to be utilized with care in your apparel.




Figure 7 Split-complementary

(E) Triad color scheme:

A triad color scheme combines three tones, which are equidistant on the wheel. Examples are red, yellow, and blue, or purple, green, and orange. It has a lot of difference. To soften the contrast, one may decide to join satisfying values and intensities.




Figure 8 Triad color




Figure 9 warm and cool colours

2.9 VISUAL EFFECTS OF COLOR IN DRESS

A single color for a whole outfit makes a person looks thinner and taller. When mixing two colors in an outfit, special precautions are required. Sharply contrasting colors seem to shorten the body. This impact can best be utilized for an exceptionally tall person, separating the top and lower part of the dress.

Colors respond with one another and the impacts they give depending on how light, dark or strong the colors are. Dark, cool and dull colors make objects to seem smaller than similar objects in warm, light or bright colors. Warm and bright colors make a form seem bigger due the colors advancing characteristics. Such colors are white, yellow, orange and red.

When two hues of identical tone are utilized together, they cause visual 'conflicting' – colors seem to jump around because they both compete similarly for consideration. This impact is decreased by changing the tone of one or both the colors. In most cases one ought not to utilize more than three significant colors in an outfit. It is ideal to utilize one color for a large area and another color or two for smaller areas. 3.1 INTRODUCTION

A graphic representation of the model is the fashion figure. It is basically a line drawing with an emphasis on the posture and adding some striking highlights to the figure. A novice can get going with faint strokes in the beginning and correcting the incorrect lines. A finished figure is then redrawn with bold strokes. A tracing paper can be utilized to follow the straightforward diagrams of the figure. This can be utilized as a layout.

Fashion Illustration is the art of communicating fashion thoughts in a visual structure that starts with illustration, drawing and painting known as Fashion sketching. It is principally utilized by fashion designers to brainstorm their thoughts on paper or carefully.

3.2 TYPES OF FASHION FIGURES

A fashion figure is not the same as a regular figure drawing in a way that it is a more dramatic, less detailed representation featuring more exaggerated movement and proportion. Fashion figures can basically take any shape you want elaborately permitting you to truly express your style creatively. The fashion figures are similar to the human body because vast majority like to introduce their designs and illustrations in figures that look like a genuine person.

3.2.1 Female Figure

There are three most popular fashion figures, and their properties

The Eight Heads Figure

The eight heads figure is the one with closer proportions to the genuine human body. In the pictures underneath you can see an illustration of a fashion figure with an eight heads size, and furthermore the similarity between the eight heads figure and the human body.




Figure 1 Eight Head Figure

The Nine Heads Figure

This figure is taller than the real human body by one head. Furthermore, the stretching is created below the waist. In the picture, you can see the proportion of the nine heads figure and the parts of the body. As you can see, the torso has the same proportions as the 8-heads figure, but the legs are longer to get a more stylish look.




Figure 2 Nine Head Figure

The Ten Heads Figure

This figure is considerably taller than the normal human body and the size of the torso and arms also change.

If you need longer fashion figures, this is your size (10-heads height). What's more, you need significantly longer figures; you can add more head sizes underneath the waist. In the picture beneath you can see the proportions of the ten-heads figure and the parts of the body.




Figure 3 Ten Head Figure

For fashion purposes, the body is extended and elongated to nine head and sometimes ten head sizes (always below the waist only). This lengthening is given to make the fashion figure look more in stylish and chic.

That is the reason in books or other people's videos there is a mention of the eight-head, or nine-head, or ten-head figures.

3.2.2 Male figure

Drawing and dressing the male figure has been simplified to help you master the basics, you will be equipped to create your own version of the male figure. After learning these basics, you will be equipped to create your own version of the male figure.

To draw the male fashion figure is to work with an idealized body, just as you have done with the female figure. You should explore drawing from the complex reality of a life figure and the fashion simplification of the stylized figure. After you have accomplished this, you can create your own artistic version of the figure in a more personal style.



3.3 IMPORTANCE OF FASHION ILLUSTRATION

As a fashion designer imagine how taxing it would have been if you just needed to portray your ideas. In some cases you might be tempted to draft a picture with your words but still the fact remains that a

picture speaks more than a thousand words. Fashion designers needs fashion illustration for better capability.

Fashion illustration shapes the initial face of every design. It can be characterized as the basic transmission of a thought into a creative design through diagrams and drawings. Fashion illustration is a visual method of explaining different design ideas.

In simple words, fashion design illustration is an art by which fashion can be explained, illustrated, and communicated. Since you realize what fashion illustration is, one can understand how important it is for a typical fashion designer.

Fashion illustration helps a designer to pen down his / her thoughts practically. This, in turn, helps in visualizing the thoughts and concepts surrounding the design. The visual guides, for example, diagrams and images convey messages inside them and become a communication medium for the designer. Illustration brings to light the important details that need more focus and attention. They structure the foundation on which the whole planning and approach for the design of a specific article of clothing or accessory depend on.

3.4 DRAWING OF FASHION FIGURE STEP BY STEP


Fashion illustration is an expertise that is created over time contingent upon lots of patience and practice. Maybe the most rewarding part about learning how to draw a fashion figure is having the fashion figure sketch your own clothes design thoughts in an easy, clear way.

There are a few simple steps you can follow that will assist you with keeping away some of the confusion with proportion and movement and permit you to focus and prioritize when drawing clothing. Before tackling the clothing sketches, it is first important to understand how to draw a fashion figure. Drawing the figure first and afterward dressing it with your design thoughts won't just assist you to bring the clothing item to life, it will also allow for a much simpler sketching process and understanding of basic fabric drape, fit and movement.

- **Step 1:** Draw a curved vertical line in one continuous movement. Try not to stress over how straight or how curved the line is, simply free-hand a vertical line. This will fill in as your upward vertical line.
- **Step 2:** Next, define a slanted horizontal line less than half of the distance down from the highest point of the vertical line as shown in the picture below.
- **Stage 3:** From the horizontal line you just drew and (the hip line) divided the top part of the vertical line in 3 sections. Draw dash lines to assist you visualize the division better. The first part from the hip line up ought to be

roughly a similar length as the upper most part of the vertical line. The center part ought to be slightly more than the two outer parts described. Look at the picture below and notice the proportion between this dash

lines - try to duplicate this placement in your drawing.

Step 4: On the first dash from the top draw another horizontal slanted line in the other way to the hip line. This will serve as the shoulder line.


As depicted over, the shoulder line and hip lines work conditionally when it comes to movement. They ought to consistently be slanted in opposite ways to achieve the right figure pose. The more slanted the lines are the more exaggerated the movement will be, generally resulting about a more dramatic looking fashion figure.

Move down to the next dash (directly in the center) and sketch a smaller horizontal line that is just a little bit slanted in a similar way as the hip line-This will mark the waist line.

Keep in mind that the waist line ought to be a lot shorter than the hip and shoulder lines. Try not to fret about careful distance at this point as long as you keep this proportion in mind.

Stage 5: Note the distance between the waist line and the hip line. Utilize this half estimation and place a horizontal dash line along the vertical balance line at this distance down from the hip line - this will check the crotch line. If this sounds somewhat confounding, utilize the sketches below as reference.

Stage 6: Now draw and connect the dots portion: You will connect the shoulders to the waist, the waist to the hips and the hips to the bottom center dash on both side of the figure. This will finish an unfinished draft of the torso and you will finally begin to see your fashion figure rise up out of the relative multitude of lines.




Step 7: Starting the side hip, define a semi-curved line (with the curve opening down) to the edge of the lower most dash line (crotch line). Repeat this step on the two sides of the hips.

Step 8: Returning to our vertical balance line: mark a dash line at the midpoint between the hip line and the lower part of the vertical line. This will mark a general (approximate) position / proportion for the knees.

Define straight or slightly curved lines beginning at the underwear line down to the area of the knee placement. The direction of the leg ought to point away from the vertical balance line.

Draw the lower part of the leg by bringing the leg direction straight,

equally in relation to the vertical center line.





Step 9: When drawing the second leg, follow a similar concept but position both the top part of the leg (thigh) and lower part of the leg straight according to the vertical center line.

Step 10: When the figure is standing straight, the elbows will be lined up with the waist and the wrist will be adjusted to the hip line.

When the hips and shoulders change with movement, the wrists and the elbows will change with it. This means that if the hip is facing up on one side, the wrist of the arm related with it will presently be aligned up with the upper thigh area. Following that equivalent logic, the elbow situation will also move downwards and adjust nearer to the hip line.

In the picture above, you can see the connection between the hips and waist to the elbows and wrists of the two arms.




Step 11: When it comes to drawing the neck, make sure to consistently utilize single stroke lines. This results in a more natural, free drawing. Drawing the neck is the place where this can truly profit the development of your fashion figure.

Draw the general shape of the head utilizing more squared lines for the jaw area. You don't have to draw a full, closed circle - this is often very difficult to do for a novice so sketch out the overall shape of the head utilizing a few simple lines that are not entirely oval.

Divide the face in 4 equivalent parts of utilizing a horizontal and vertical dash line. Ensure the horizontal line is slightly curved, such as to show the natural shape of the oval face.

Step 12: Sketch the eyebrows utilizing the eye placement as a guide. Utilizing a straightforward dash line for the nose is sufficient to give your fashion figure a finished look. Keep the lips basic by drawing a basic impression of the bottom and top lip without worrying too much connecting all the lines together.

Step 13: Draw the outline of the shape and fill it in with only a few lines to depict the hair. Try to visualize the movement of the hairstyle and capture it in your drawing utilizing a few simple basic lines. Add more lines where the hair is fuller. Try not to draw completely closed shapes.

Step 14: If you are having a hard time with some of the steps mentioned here, start over and keep practicing. It is very ordinary not

to get the hang of it right away. Remember that drawing a fashion figure is something to be mastered over time.

Step 15: Use the movement of your fashion figure to draw the right fabric drape. When you have the fashion figure drawn, this is not easy to do by following the hip and shoulder placement. Make the waistline of your garment a bit curved to make more 3 - dimensional movement. This is especially relevant if you are drawing a high waist skirt or jeans. Curve the waist just slightly, with the curve opening up, to ensure that the cylindrical shape of the waist is shown in your sketch.


3.5 DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FIGURES

3.5.1 Difference between male figure and female figure

The male and female both figures are the same height. They are drawn using the same grid system of "heads tall". Placement on this grid of the major body section is relatively equal between the figures.

The fashion male's chest makes more of a thicker and his shoulders are broader, but the hips are narrower, without the curve that is drawn on the fashion female.


A) The jaw line and the neck are given more emphasis on the male figure. The masculine jaw is drawn with a more pronounced chin. The neck is drawn much thicker than you would draw the female's neck.

- B) The male figure's shoulders are drawn much wider than the female's. Measure the distance from center front to the outside edge of the shoulder, across the male's body. Double that distance between the left and right side of the body. Notice, the male's arms are almost twice as thick as the female's.
- C) While the feminine waistline is reduced unbelievably, the masculine waist line is fairly normal in a fashion sketch. The difference is that the man's waist can be drawn lower on the body.
- D) The curve of the male's hip is less shaped and not as round as the female's.
- E) Men's legs are drawn thicker and shorter than the female's. The knee cap can also be more pronounced, along with a slight exaggeration in the thigh and calf areas.
- 3.5.2 Difference between normal human body and fashion figure of female

It all begins with the height of the respective figures. So a typical human figure's height is equal to the eight times the height of its head. Now a quintessential fashion figure is equal to the nine times the height of its head. This is in consideration of the fact that the heights of the head of both figures are the same.



Measurements taken while drawing human and a fashion figure

Common measurements

Height between each line = $\frac{1}{2}$ inch

Height of head = $\frac{1}{2}$ inch

Human body figure

Height of body inch = $3\frac{1}{2}$ Total height of figure = 4 inch

Fashion figure

Height of body = 4 inch

Total height of figure inch = $4\frac{1}{2}$

There is a reason as to why fashion figure illustrations are taller than human figure illustrations. This has mainly got to do with the fact that fashion models are taller than a normal human.

3.6.1 Female fashion figure

Balance Line in fashion figure

Balance Line gets its name from the housing construction term, the plumb line, which is a line that runs completely straight down to and is perpendicular to the floor line. For model drawing, you can start the balance line at the base of the neck and run it straight down the figure, finishing it at the floor line. This line will keep your figure standing up straight without looking as though it will tip over on your page.



Matching poses to garments

From the marketing point of view, posed fashion figures can do more than just wear clothes in a sketch. Poses create shapes, and those shapes convey a design story. Before drawing, you have to understand what kind of shapes is available and why they will work for you. These pages examine three particular poses and the shapes that they make. There are many variants on this theme. After practicing these three, invent your own pose.



I pose: There are no lines of action in this position. Here the figure is static, standing still, and not posing.

S pose: A narrow contained pose. The arms and legs are subdued and are without action.

X pose: A wide-open, active pose. The arms and legs move away from the torso for a sense of motion.




Figure 3 Toddlers




Figure 4 Child




Figure 5 Teen



Calico: Calico is a sub-material of cotton. It is the original version of cotton, which essentially means that it is made using the same process, but production is stopped before the cotton is completely processed. When used with polyurethane coatings, nylon is a good fabric choice. Nylon can absorb water better than polyester, so it can absorb water better. It is most commonly used for tight-knit jackets that can retain heat due to poor air permeability. It is used for more breathable sweatshirts, where it can work well.

Cotton: Cotton clothing has both softness and comfort; however, it is not recommended to use cotton cloth in the bottom clothing because it will absorb and retain moisture.

Our preferred method at Shirt works is to first pass the garment through the dryer so that most of the "gas reaction" occurs before printing. This "boils" most of the gas, but not all of it. A gray base with a lower curing temperature holds and seals the fabrics in place before our plastisol is applied to them. The lower curing temperature means that as the substrate heals faster, the gas permeation effect at the curing point will be further reduced.



- 7. Polypropylene: Polypropylene does not absorb liquid moisture. However, due to body temperature, moisture can penetrate the polypropylene fabric. The advantage of polypropylene is that it has an insulating effect when wet and can be melted in a household dryer at moderate temperatures. Due to its hydrophobicity and very good thermal properties, effective moisture management keeps users warm in cold weather and cold in hot weather.
- 8. Spandex: Spandex is another material most commonly used in sportswear and sportswear. This is due to its high elasticity, which makes the garment flexible and comfortable during strenuous exercise. As we all know, this material can be stretched to 100 times its original size, making it the material of choice for global sportswear manufacturers. Known for its ability to absorb sweat, breathe and dry quickly, it is usually an ideal choice for inexpensive, flexible, and versatile materials. The only drawback is that it is difficult to embroider because the material does not support the stitch design well.

- 9. Nylon: Nylon fabric is light, strong, soft, and has good abrasion resistance. Nylon is fast even when wet. When used with polyurethane coatings, nylon is a good fabric choice. Nylon has a much higher moisture recovery rate than polyester, so it can absorb moisture better. It is most commonly used for tight-knit jackets that can retain heat due to poor air permeability. It is also used for more breathable sweatshirts, where it can work well.
- 10. Cotton: Cotton clothing has both softness and comfort; however, it is not recommended to use cotton cloth in the bottom clothing because it will absorb and retain moisture.
- 11. viscose: close-fitting viscose is not the first choice because it retains moisture in sportswear. The outer layer of the woven hydrophilic part of the two-layer sportswear can be made of viscose, and its moisture absorption is 23 times that of cotton. Improve absorbency by adding some hydrophobic coatings.

10.3 CRITERIA KEPT IN MIND WHILE SKETCHING (DESIGNING) NIGHT WEAR

We spend 33% of our life sleeping, so when it comes down to it, comfortable nightwear can be difficult to choose with so many different styles, fabrics, colours, and prints.

There are some important points given below to keep in mind while sketching or designing nightwear.

> Fabric

The most important thing when sketching a nightwear is what season we are designing it for.

When sketching, take special care of the design of the place to be worn, and the climate of the place. Some fabrics are lightweight and made for warmer temperatures, while others have thicker material that is better for winter temperatures.

When sketching or designing the nightwear, we should consider a fabric with smooth, soft, breathable texture. It should not irritate one's skin

Especially for Children, particularly infants, have delicate and sensitive skin. There are alternative choices like soy-based fabrics that are sustainable (gentle on the climate) and silky-smooth (delicate on babies) which is ideal for child garments. While sketching or designing any outfit, it is important to always thing about the comfort of the people.

After fabric, the next important criteria to keep in mind is the cut and outline of your sleep suits or night shirts

When making sketches of night dresses, special care should be taken to ensure that the nightwear is an outfit to make the person feel relaxed during sleep. Choose a simple pattern during sketching of nightwear so that the person does not have any difficulty in movement during sleep. It should not fitted to the body. Design a pattern that stays slightly free from body (loose fitting), so that the person feels comfortable during sleep.

When sketching or designing children nightwear, you should think about their usefulness. For infants, they would go through the majority of their day sleeping, so definitely select something comfortable pattern like a kimono bodysuit, onesies, sleep sack, baby footies, or a gown. > Colour

> Print

Print also plays an important role in garment designing.

There are few thing to keep in mind when choosing a prints when sketching a nightwear, such as age group, season, skin tone, trend, etc. For example, while preparing sketches of nightwear for children, fruits, alphabets, cartoons, animals etc. could be used, it will be more appropriate to choose such prints. For sketching adult's night dresses designer can show typographical prints in sketch too.

> Fastener

Knowledge of fasteners is essential when designing night wear.

Usually, fasteners are used for opening in garments and also for joining two parts of garments.

Avoid showing the use of fasteners in designing nightwear until done, or mention the use of classic fasteners only like, Simple Button, Zipper, and Velcro.




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


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

It shows patriotism, festivity, unity and belongingness, and much more. Thus, we should try to be educated enough to know how to wear specific traditional garments. Wearing these garments with respect is basically a humble verse to tradition and cultures, so wearing these in a wrong or in an inappropriate way during a specific festive gettogethers, may insult somebody's dignity. People should remain concerned while wearing the traditional dress of some different cultures since they need a high rank of discipline, concern and harmony.

People should continue to wear traditional garments on festivals and cultural occasions and in ordinary day to day lives to keep promoting them as they make the culture popular and appealing.

There are numerous valid reasons to opt for traditional garments, so in this topic we will discuss a couple of motives that how traditional dress can be the best option to go for.

Most of the traditional cultures are very concerned about keeping themselves covered in a modest manner. Each culture gives the most modest clothes to wear as per their standards and moral values.

The traditional clothes are basically a symbol of belongingness to respective country. Wearing traditional garments represents national identity and love for them.

Traditional garments are best to wear for comfort purposes particularly based on occasions and festivals. For the traditional appearance and to meet the comfort levels, wearing traditional garments is still popular.

The traditional garments are one in themselves who gives the feeling of closeness and comfort to the everyday exercises relying upon the situations. Even they are the fundamental elements of the our festivals.

The traditional garments basically address culture and identity. To hold on to the traditions and to continue to follow, them it's important to keep them as a part of our everyday lifestyle. If we will not promote our traditional dress than no one else will. It essentially represent our national identity, culture, and traditions.

Even the youngsters who used to prefer wearing traditional clothes are more in touch with their tribal cultures, faith and sentiments just as they are not confused with their identity that who they are, what's their history and to whom they belong to.

11.3 CRITERIA KEPT IN MIND WHILE SKETCHING (DESIGNING) TRADITIONAL GARMENT

- It is important to pay attention to the essentials of designing a garment, just like the traditional garments, it is important to keep in mind the importance of what a garment portrays.
- India is country with vast diversity. This diversity is also found in religion, language, and outfits. Different states of India have respective history, religion, climate, etc. similarly the traditional dress also varies to corresponding states.
- Before designing the traditional wear of any state, one should first know the history, culture, festivals, climate etc. of that state.
- The pattern, color, motifs and embellishment design should be chosen while sketching the traditional costume of the state.
- The traditional outfit of different states are the distinctive identity of respective states. So distinguishing changes must be avoided.

11.4 DIFFERENT TYPES OF TRADITIONAL WEAR

• Traditional Dresses of Indian States Gujarat:

The traditional wear of Gujarat is unique in its own way. The women wear Chaniya choli, Chaniya is a coloured petticoat embroidered with glass pieces and colourful thread works while choli is a coloured piece of coarse cloth covering the upper body.

Along with the beautiful clothing, ladies decorate themselves with sparkling ornaments. Men wear Chrono and Kediyu, yet these days instead of wearing traditional outfits, people wears western clothes.

Karnataka:

The traditional dress for ladies in Karnataka is a saree made of silk. Karnataka is known as the Silk hub of India as a wide range of silk is profused here. Mysore and Banglore are famous for their silk industries. Kanchipuram or Kanjeevaram silks of Karnataka are very famous all over India. The traditional dress for men in Karnataka is Lungi, worn under the waist below a shirt. Mysore Peta is a traditional headdress for men.

Kerala:

The traditional apparel of ladies in Kerala is the 'Kerala Saree' or the Mundum Neriyathum. This is in two pieces, one is draped on the lower part of the body and then the neriyathu is worn over a blouse. Generally men in Kerala are more conservative than ladies and stick to tradition. Mundu is worn on the lower part of the body and is a garment tucked around the waist, it reaches to their ankles. Many of them like to wear it over their waist and the higher caste people drape a fabric over their shoulders.

Maharashtra:

Traditional garments for Maharashtrian men include the dhoti, also called dhotar, and pheta, while a choli and nine-yard saree locally known as Nauwari Saadi or Lugda worn by for ladies.

Traditional dress is well known in rural areas while traditional people from city areas likewise wear these garments. These garments are worn by Maharashtrians while celebrating different festivals.

Punjab:

The traditional dress for women is the salwar suit which replaced the traditional Punjabi ghaghra. The Punjabi suit is made up of a kurta or kameez and a straight-cut salwar. The Patiala salwar is also popular in India.

The traditional dress for Punjabi men is the kurta and tehmat, which is being replaced by the kurta and pajama, particularly the famous muktsari

style in India. It is called muktsari style because of its origin in Muktsar in Punjab.

Rajasthan:

Traditionally men wear dhotis, kurta, angarkha, and paggar or safa (type of turban headgear). Chudidar pajama (puckered pants) often replaces dhoti in different regions. Women wear ghaghra (long skirt) and Kanchi (top). However, the dress style changes with the lengths and breadths accordingly to vast Rajasthan. Dhoti is worn in various styles in Marwar (Jodhpur region) or Shekhawati (Jaipur region) or Hadoti (Bundi region).

Manipur:

Innaphi and Phanek are the Manipuri traditional dress for ladies in Manipur. A shawl or dupatta called Innaphi and a skirt called a Phanek, which are wrapped over the chest. The dress is woven with hands in horizontal lines.

Men wear dhotis which is four and a half meters long. These are wrapped around the waist and legs and is knotted at the waist, and matched with smart coats or bundis. Headgear is a white pagri or turban.

Meghalaya:

Meghalaya has three main tribes Khasi, Jaintias, and Garos, and the traditional dress of every tribe is popular. The traditional Khasi female dress is known as the Jainsem or Dhara, the two of which are somewhat elaborated with several pieces of cloth, giving the body a round and hollow shape. The traditional Khasi male dress is a Jymphong, a longish sleeveless coat without a collar, fastened by straps in front.

A Garo lady also wears a shirt and an unstitched 'lungi' like cloth which is known as 'Dakmanda.' It is affixed around the waist. Both Garo people enjoy adorning themselves with ornaments. The ladies of the Jaintia tribes wear a velvet blouse along with a sarong called 'Thoh Khyrwang' which is wrapped over the waistline.

Jammu and Kashmir:

The Pheran is a prominent clothing for Kashmiri ladies. The Pheran is worn by ladies usually has Zari, embroidery on the hemline, around pockets, and generally on the collar area. Women prefer a suit and Burkha in summer and Pheran are liked in autumn.

The typical dress of a Kashmiri man both Hindu and Muslim is Pheran, a long loose gown hanging down below the knees. The men wear a skullcap, a fitting salwar (Muslims), or churidar pajama (Pandits).

Andhra Pradesh:

Andhra Pradesh is a southern state in India. It imparts its boundaries to Telangana, Chhattisgarh, and Odisha with the Bay of

Bengal in the east and is called the "Rice Bowl of India" as they grow plenty of rice.

Andhra Pradesh is viewed as the Kohinoor of India for its popular weaving and dying industry. The customary wear of Andhra Pradesh is similarly as in other southern Indian states. Men generally wear kurta and dhoti, while lungis are additionally worn with a kurta. Muslim men wear pajamas with kurta instead of the dhoti.

The women of Andhra Pradesh wear saree and they are original handloom sarees, young women wear Langa Voni. For wedding functions, the bride wears silk sarees which are red and decorated with gold plating, while the bride groom wears kurta and full-length dhoti.

With the influence of western culture people of city areas wear western garments in the workplace/work environment. Women like to wear salwar kameez or western attire rather than saree. Youth and children wear pants, shirts, and T-shirts.

West Bengal:

Bengali women generally wear the white cotton sari with red border in wedding and in casual wear salwar kameez. The traditional dress for men like a dhoti, Panjabi, kurta, sherwani, pajama, and lungi are seen during weddings and festivals.

Sikkim:

The traditional outfit of Lepcha women is called Dumvum or Dumdyam. It's an ankle length outfit worn like a sari. Another outfit worn is Nyamrek which is beautifully attached to the blouse. Another local community Bhutia wears Bakhu or Kho outfits. It is a loose, clock style piece of clothing that is fastened at the neck on one side and near the waist with a silk or cotton belt.

Males wear loose pants under the Kho. The traditional outfit is complemented by embroidered leather boots by both women and men.

Arunachal Pradesh:

Arunachal Pradesh is the north-eastern state of India bordering with Nagaland and Assam toward the south, while Myanmar toward the east, Bhutan in the west, and China toward the north. Their dresses are very vibrant, bright and their myriad patterns change with various tribes. The attire of Arunachal Pradesh is remarkable and well known all over India.

The Monpas, the Buddhist people group are well known for their skull cap, women wear sleeveless chemise with a long coat. There is a narrow strip of cloth that they tie around their waist to keep chemise fixed.

Bamboo hoops (earrings) and silver studs are normal ornaments. Females of tribes living in the lower Kamla valley have a curious outfit. They tie their hairs in a knot simply over their forehead.

Men wear sleeveless material made of silk with two edges stuck to the shoulder area. The apparel is knee-long and its trademark is the skull cap smeared with hairs of yak.

Tang's tribe people decorate outfits which is the style of Burmese. Men wear sleeveless shirts and lungi of green colour with white, red, and yellow yarn. Ladies wear a woven slip with a petticoat. Miji women wear long cloaks and big earrings.

Assam:

Assam is surrounded by seven northeastern states in India. The traditional wear for men is dhoti-kurta and for women they wear 'Mekhela-Chador' or 'Riha-Mekhela'.

This traditional dress is made from the prestigious 'Muga Silk' which is peculiar, just as the pride of Assam. They additionally wear 'Dokhora' and dresses like a salwar suit, sari, and so forth. Women feel proud to wear handloom items, particularly Mekhela chador, during special occasions like weddings and festivals like Bihu and Saraswati puja.

The women of the Bodo Tribe wear Mekhela matched with a chadar while ladies of the Thai Phake Tribe wear a striped gridle called Chiarchin. The traditional dress worn by the menfolk of Assam is 'Suria' or 'dhoti' and 'kameez' or 'shirt' and over it, a chadar known as 'Seleng' is muffuled.

Bihar

The traditional dress of the Bihar includes the dhoti-mirjai or the kurta for men and Saree for women. The effects of western culture have additionally influenced the lives of people in Bihar where women like to wear saree or Kameez-Salwar.

The saree is worn traditionally in "Seedha Aanchal" style . Western shirts and pants are additionally getting popular in both the rural and urban male populace.

12.1 INTRODUCTION

Functional Clothing is a moderately new and exciting section of the technical textile group — one which is responsive to new product development and technologies and abounding with special applications. The development of performance clothing has been fuelled by recent breakthroughs and advances in specialized filaments and fabrics and advances in garment manufacturing technologies. A lot of technologies initially developed for military applications have additionally opened up in the public area and structure a significant constituent of this field. Viability of new fibers, fabrics or finishes is frequently checked with an eye on their application in functional clothing design, underlining the 'evolutionary' segment of textiles.

The field of functional clothing is wide and different with each functionality having its own specification, material prerequisites, subsequent technologies and processes. A large part of the technology utilized is among the most sophisticated accessible at any given point of time. End use applications are different and quite complex, going from lifesaving and hostile environment receptive to those working on the personal satisfaction. Owing to its evolutionary nature, the information accessible regarding the matter of functional clothing is divided and generally secured. There is confusion about what really establishes the domain of functional clothing as the area has never really been defined or grouped.

Definition

All apparel is known to perform multiple functions – from aesthetic to essential protection from the elements. 'Functional clothing' can accordingly be characterized as a generic term that incorporates all such kinds of apparel or assemblies that are specifically designed to deliver a pre - defined performance or usefulness to the client, over and above its normal functions. Such apparel would generally be produced using a mix of creative materials, and usefulness for this situation would suggest the additional worth or capacity that a piece of clothing is expected to perform. It very well may be clothing that protects people who are exposed to dangerous or unsafe conditions during work or during sporting activities; or that can work with development and body balance in physically challenged people or that improve stamina or reduce fatigue in sports people. It can likewise be clothing that plays out an absolutely aesthetic function like enhancing body shapes. Functional clothing can have electronic functionalities with applications in correspondence and telemedicine. Functional clothing assemblies are ergonomically designed to have a base inhibitory effect on movement and give maximum comfort and performance to the client. Ordinary stylish considerations are often overridden in favor of performance.

12.2 IMPORTANCE OF FUNCTIONAL CLOTHING

Functional clothing addresses the evolutionary segment of the technical textiles market, representing an area where clothing crosses the regular limits and incorporates with the areas of medication, biotechnology, nanotechnology, physical science and computing among others, to meet the multi-layered and complex requirements of the users. Functional clothing by definition is user requirement specific and designed or engineered to meet the performance prerequisites of the user under extreme conditions. A variety of functional clothing items are accessible in the market as defensive dress, clinical attire or active wear.

12.3 CLASSIFICATION OF FUNCTIONAL CLOTHING

Standard classification utilized for technical textiles, like Protech (defensive textiles), Sportech (sports materials) and Meditech (medical textiles) covers primarily the textiles and not generally the end product, except if the product get utilized in that form for example in case of geotextiles. Development of items utilizing these materials or textiles for specific end utility opens a totally new area of intervention with overlaps in other arising technologies and areas. When applied to clothing, the new products cover a vast and different domain of all things considered and are termed as 'Functional Clothing'. Design and development of

functional clothing items is driven by the selection of materials, as characterized by the social, psychological or physiological prerequisites of the client; selection of technologies as characterized by wanted usefulness; and ergonomic consideration, assembly methods, sizing and fit.

Five classes, thoroughly covering most logical types of functional clothing, that are currently in use or are a work in progress, have been proposed. Each distinct class may have sub - classes with similar standards overseeing the design of items within that sub-class, even as the end results may discover application in a variety of fields, for example protective functional clothing may discover an application as defensive military armor, as sports armor or in surgical gowns for the doctors.

The proposed classification, however, doesn't cover all the areas where functional clothing is required yet rather just those where items are as of now accessible or are currently being developed. Further, while the classes are distinct as far as usefulness and along these lines the principles of design employed, materials and processes might be common across the classes relying upon their field of application.

12.4 DIFFERENT TYPES OF FUNCTIONAL CLOTHING

1. Protective - functional

Protective functional clothing addresses the largest and most diverse segment of functional clothing. The usefulness of clothing in this case can make the difference between life and death for the client; at any rate, it can allow individuals to work in and around hostile conditions, improve the quality of life and prevent or reduce injuries. The protective usefulness can be sub-classified into 3 categories based on the nature of the threat from which protection is required. The technical prerequisites for each situation are quite specific and distinct.

• Environmental Hazard Protective

The idea of danger for this situation is extreme environmental conditions (natural or man-made) like extreme heat or cold, fire, rain, snow, dust, wind or UV, against which protection is wanted. The critical design necessity here is to protect the body from exposure to extreme elements in the climate (say temperature) while simultaneously working with the transport of metabolic heat and moisture from the body. Fundamental requirements would be acceptable protection with lower weight and bulk and ergonomic design according to mobility prerequisite of the application, for example scuba diving suits, mountaineering suits and firemen

• Biological, Chemical and Radiation (BCR) Hazard Protective

BCR hazard are additionally present in the climate yet the nature of threat addressed by them and the resulting protection requirements are entirely unexpected from the main classification. The basic design requirement for this situation would be to create a barrier to prevent the ingestion, penetration or skin contact of hazard chemicals, poisonous gases, body fluids, germs or radioactive particulate matter. Particular coatings and laminates are the primary materials utilized in these products. Often such attire will be totally closed, and may thus require cooling, breathing or metabolic waste removal capacities to be incorporated into the clothing system itself.

Clothing for doctors and health workers establishes a significant part of biological protective clothing, while industrial and military apparel are designed to provide protection from chemicals and radiation dangers. Clean room clothing then again is utilized to prevent the escaping of submicron particles from the human body to the environment to prevent contaminating the item or environment in which one is working. The guideline of design for these product would likewise be based on barrier properties, however in the reverse direction.

• Injury Protective

Nature of danger for this situation is in the form of mild to fatal injuries caused by ballistic, blunt and mechanical effect or cut and slash risks from a variety of sources. Guideline of protection in such cases is essentially material based and that of impact resistance. Ballistic injuries are high impact injuries and antiballistic clothing is the oldest type of defensive apparel known to man. Numerous layers of high strength filaments, ceramics, metal sheets and composites are utilized to obtain soft / semi-hard / hard armors with an ideal blend of light weight and high protection depend upon perceived nature of hazard. Blunt injuries can be caused under a large group of circumstances. Some are caused during extreme sports, for example, motor biking and snowboarding. Others might be caused in man - man crashes during sporting events like rugby or football, or as high speed ball injuries during ball games like cricket or hockey. Law authorization faculty may support blunt impact injuries caused by projectiles and blunt objects.

Again a variety of soft / semi-hard / hard armors and guards are utilized for protection. For this situation, armors consist of shock absorbing EVA (ethylene vinyl acetate) and PU (polyurethane) foams in combination with energy-scattering hard sheets produced using polymers or composites. A new advancement has been as nanotechnology based shear thickening fluids or 'fluid covering'. These are smart polymers that are light weight, flexible, and liquid in the first place that harden on sudden

impact. They adjust to the body shape easily and keep the wearer comfortable.

Defensive attire is also required for protection from occupational cut and stab injuries caused during meat cutting, working with chain saw, glass and blades. Law authorization staff, emergency workers and forest workers additionally face these dangers. High strength filaments like steel, aramid or HDPE, woven into light weight fabrics are utilized to design coats, gloves, aprons, sleeves, watches and inserts for such applications. These fabrics treated with shear thickening liquids create puncture and stab resistant apparel which is flexible and light in weight.

2. Medical - functional

For a long time, basic garments like patients' and surgeons' gowns, aprons, and gloves are called 'medical clothing'. The essential usefulness of these dress being protection from body liquids, germs, and so on. Such products are covered under the defensive usefulness. Clinical usefulness currently encompasses much wider and modern applications to cover therapeutic, bio - sensing, emergency care and recovery exercises as talked about beneath fewer than two sub classes.

• Therapeutic and Rehabilitative Clothing

Pressing therapy through compression pieces of clothing is a grounded line of treatment for hypertrophic scars, burns injuries, venous and lymphatic disorders. Utilization of pressure garments brings an expansion in venous blood flow in the lower limits, thus helping with venousthrombosis. Pressing factor is imparted by utilization of stretch fabric containing flexible yarns. Military clothing needs to provide protection from ballistic injury just as risks of environmental, nuclear, chemical and biological nature. It must have compatibility with other stuff components like helmet, gas mask, ballistics gear, survival vest, cooling system and

hand and foot gear; allow for communication (GPS, monitoring and discreet gadgets) and at the same time be comfortable in extreme postures and activity for long periods of time.

A modern space suit is an extreme example of how complex an attire framework can get. It's made of up to 18,000 odd parts and up to 11 layers, and needs to have all that a space explorer requires to remain alive — oxygen, water, temperature control and carbon dioxide removal; give stable internal pressing; shield against radiation; protect against micrometeoroids, etc.

Types





14.1 INTRODUCTION

An accessory is used in fashion as an item to contribute, in a secondary manner, to a person's outfit. Accessories are often chosen to complete an outfit and complement the wearer's look. Accessories have the ability to further express a person's identity and personality. Accessories come in various shapes, sizes, colour, and so forth.

Types

Generally fashion accessories can be approximately categorized into two areas: (1) those that are carried and (2) those that are worn.

Generally carried accessories include purses, handbags, hand fans, parasols, umbrellas, wallets, and ceremonial swords.

Accessories that are worn may incorporate coats, boots and shoes, cravats, ties, caps, hoods, belts and suspenders, gloves, muffs, eyewear, necklace, bracelets, watches, scarves, shawls, socks, pins, piercings, rings, and stockings.

The type of accessories that an individual decides to wear or carry to complement their outfit can be determined by a few factors, including the particular context of where the person is going. For example, if an individual is going to work their choice of accessory would vary from somebody who is going out for dinner. In this way depending on work or event different accessories would be picked. Additionally, a person's economic status, religious and cultural background would also be a contributing factor.

History

In Victorian fashion accessories like fans, parasols and gloves held importance for how ladies experienced gender, race, and class. In this time, there was a trend for women to embrace, or desire, a more leisure lifestyle. Apparently, gloves were regularly utilized by ladies to cover their hands which also masked (covered) any signs of labour.

14.2IMPORTANCE OF ACCESSORIES

An accessory is an additional item to a user's clothing which is normally used to finish an outfit and completes the appearance of the user.

Clothes can portray one's personality but accessories are more important than you think. Accessories and garments are equally significant in your outfit, Working together to create a harmony that expresses who you are and enhances your beauty http.

- It is important to have an idea for which purpose or occasion we are going to design the accessory.
- Some occasions like wedding; we should design heavy and classic accessory, and while other schedule like casual event or office look we should choose the delicate designs and colour combinations.
- Some accessories are also used as a religious symbols, so keep in mind while designing of those kind of accessories as it should not hurt the sentiment of peoples.

Rings

Bangles and Bracelets

Bangles and Bracelets are accessories worn around the wrist. The different between a bangle and a bracelet is that a bangle is more rigid than a bracelet and is more circular in shape. You can also count bands around the wrist like friendship bands.

Nose Rings

Nose piercings have a long history. In 1500 BCE, Lakshmi wore nose rings according to the Hindu book called Vedas. The modern practice of nose rings in India has been assessed to come from the Middle Eastern nomadic tribes that traveled to the trade routes in the sixteenth century. Customs in Indian Hindu culture incorporate that ladies of childbearing age wear a nose ring stud in their left nostril.

Nose rings and pins can be made from substances like metal, plastic, and even glass. They come in special designs and colours. Some are even studded with valuable stones like diamonds, sapphires, rubies, emeralds, and so on.

Handbags

If you ask a lady to pick her main accessory for daily life, she would precisely choose a handbag among top three options. Handbags are also called purses in American English. It's nothing but a medium-to - large bag that is often used to carry personal things. Initially, a purse was utilized to refer to small bag that held cash however handbags are bigger in size and can hold a wide range of things. Head Bands

Headbands are a clothing fashion accessory that is worn in the hair or around the forehead. Their primary function is to hold the hair away from the eyes or face. Headbands are generally horseshoe-shaped pieces of flexible metal or plastic. It can likewise be a loop of elastic material that goes right around the hair. Headbands come in a wide range of sizes, shapes, designs, and colours. Sometimes they additionally have a few attachments like bows or sequins.

Belts

A belt is an accessory you wear around your waist; it helps to tighten the waistband of garment you are wearing along with it and keep it set up, almost holding it up.

Shoes, Sandals and Boots

Sandals

Sandals are the open type of footwear. Generally used in the summers. These open type of shoes comes with straps tied around the arch of the feet. Sandals may be embellished with beads, sequins, tassels etc.

Flip flops are open – toed sandals with straps going between the toe and the rest of the fingers. It gives a very casual look. Also for best for beach look. Mules are another variety of sandals.

Boots

They are additionally accessible in a wide range of shapes, going from square, round, ovals, and square shapes to star and heart shapes!

Brooches and Pins

Brooches and pins are generally utilized as fastenings, holding folds of fabric together. Brooches are decorative pins. Pins when attached with an ornament on top it becomes brooch. Pins can likewise be worn as decorative accessory.

Scarves

A scarf is a piece of fabric worn around the neck for warmth, sun protection, cleanliness, style, or religious reasons, it also gives a sober look to our complete attire.

Hats

Hat are head covers that are often worn for protection against weather, for functions like graduations, religious reasons, safety, and as a style accessory. Hats were also a symbol of social statuses, like in the military. There are a different styles of hats that are accessible including baseball caps, berets, beanies, fedora, panama, etc.

Watches





















Figure: Images of sketches of accessories
